COVID-19 UPDATE #9

**GOVERNOR HUTCHINSON AND DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
COVID-19 GUIDANCE**

I wanted to clarify the current status regarding orders issued by the state related to COVID-19. The most recent guidance from Governor Hutchinson is from March 26, 2020, when he issued an Executive Order, [CLICK HERE](#), stating that "gatherings of more than ten (10) people in any confined indoor or outdoor space are prohibited until further notice." To clarify this directive DOES NOT apply to business, however, business is "advised to limit person-to-person contact and maintain appropriate social distancing of at least six (6) feet to prevent the spread of this virus."

The Arkansas Department of Health has offered guidance for employers based on the CDC, to include the following recommended strategies to use for any infectious disease:

- Actively encourage sick employees to stay home
- Separate sick employees
- Emphasize staying home when sick, respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene by all employees
- Perform routine environmental cleaning
- Advise employees before traveling to take certain steps

Taking these pro-active steps now could ward off exposure to the virus and limit further restrictions in the future.

**THE FAMILIES FIRST CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE ACT
FOR EMPLOYERS**

As you know, Congress passed and President Trump signed into law the \$2.2 trillion Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act. This bill, known as Phase 3, includes generous and unprecedented provisions to help provide liquidity for dealerships and to help businesses keep their employees on the payroll.
