HB 1922 AMENDED AND PASSES OUT OF STATE SENATE

After a long day of negotiations, [HB 1922](#) passed unanimously out of the state Senate minutes ago. The bill is now on its way back to the state House of Representatives for concurrence in the agreed to amendment.

Representative Jeff Wardlaw and Senator Ben Gilmore, as well as Senate Transportation, Technology, and Legislative Affairs Committee Chairman Blake Johnson were each instrumental in working through the amendment process today. This amendment was critical to ensuring the bills passage.

Today's amendment, [click here](#), clarifies the definition of digital platform, adds a review and line-item process for dealers making warranty rate requests, and corrects two drafting errors.

The General Assembly is targeting Tuesday, April 27, 2021, as the final day of the session, and we will work hard Monday and Tuesday of next week to ensure HB 1922 makes its way through the state House of Representatives before heading to Governor Hutchinson.
